Modified: 6/26 In SY 16-17 the Civics Window was open continuously for all grades. This year, there are mandatory windows in both first and second semesters for 12th graders, regardless of their "on track" status, who have yet to pass. 8th and 11th grade windows remain optional but students should be afforded at least one opportunity to test in one of the two windows. Students yet to pass may be tested more frequently at the schools discretion. Please see the above Civics cells for more details as the ending dates have also changed.

Added: 6/22 SAI is an online survey administered through ADE regarding principals. This window has been set for Mar 5 - 16

Modified: 6/22 The School Quality Survey windows for staff, students, and parents have all been set to Jan. 8 - Feb 2.
